- Program length (0.5 hour, 1 hour, 1.5 hours, 2 hours)\*
- Program type\*\* (knowledge or application)
- Objectives (3-5)
- Outline of program including proposed time for each section (note that active learning is required):
  - *Example Program Outline:*
    - *Introduction (5 minutes)*
    - *Topic background or Literature review (10 minutes)*
    - *Discussion of controversial issue (20 minutes)*
    - *Patient cases (15 minutes)*
    - *Questions and answers (10 minutes)*

*\*More than one speaker is permitted for presentations longer than 1 hour*

*\*\*Knowledge: CPE activities designed primarily for the acquisition of factual knowledge will be classified as knowledge-based activities. Information presented must be based on the current scientific evidence as accepted in the literature and free from commercial bias.*  
*Application: CPE activities designed primarily for the application of the information learned in the time frame allotted will be classified as application-based activities. Information presented must be based on the current scientific evidence as accepted in the literature and free from commercial bias. Activities will be classified as application-based if they include one or more learning objectives representative of a higher activity level.*
